START 'Sethern', Rams Lane, Dunsfold, Surrey, GU8 4NR OS Ref 186/SU 015352. At the B2130 Crossroads 6 miles south of Guildford on the A281 turn right towards Dunsfold. Follow the B2130 west for approximately 2 miles, turn left signposted Dunsfold. After 1 mile turn left in front of the Cricket Pitch, and Rams Lane is ½ Mile on the right.

Yellow route: Pre67Yellow, Sportsman, Youth Sportsman

SIGNING-ON: All competitors should sign-on. All officials please sign-on. The first solo rider will start at 10.30 am at section 1 then at 1 minute intervals. On the day it may be 2 riders every 1 minute to separate sections.

GENERAL: No practising or un-official riding in the car-park area or on the course between sections.

INSTRUCTIONS TO OBSERVERS: Please write your name, address and telephone number on the observers cards. The riding no will be marked to indicate the Blue, Red or Yellow course. Unmarked nos. will ride the White course. Marking will be as per TSR 22B (Non-Stop Trial).

ACCIDENTS: Anyone suffering personal injury during the event should notify the Secretary of the Meeting before the events ends.

INSURANCE: There will be no Personal Accident cover provided for Youths. If cover is required parents or guardians are advised to arrange it separately.
